Expectations and Academics

Academic Requirements: Our focus this school year will be learning and developing our skills as critical thinkers, readers, writers, speakers, and listeners. Students will be exploring different genres of literature and writing throughout the school year.

Reading Counts: All 6th grade students are expected to complete 500,000 words by the end of the school year. Students should be spending at least 30 minutes per night reading and providing notes to ensure adequate comprehension.

Homework: Along with Reading Counts, students will receive homework weekly. Failure to complete and submit homework will be documented in the student's Assignment Card and consequences will be based on the step process.

Citizenship: Participation in class discussions is encouraged. Staying on task, helping others, and showing respect to the classroom environment (people, furniture, materials etc) will be noted.
